**Lewisham is closing roads to create more traffic congestion and increase journey times.**

The Borough of Lewisham is proposing to close many roads in your local area as part of a programme to encourage walking, cycling and public transport use while discouraging vehicle use.

There has been minimal public consultation on these proposals which would cause enormous inconvenience to local residents and visitors apart from causing congestion on other roads.



**Lewisham Council are proposing a direct attack on vehicle owners with their “Healthy Neighbourhoods” scheme.**

The Healthy Neighbourhoods proposals will likely make traffic congestion worse, air pollution worse, make life difficult for the elderly and disabled, impede emergency services and make life more difficult in general for local residents.



## Lewisham's Road Closures—Make Sure You Oppose Them



**The first area the Council plans to cover is Lewisham and Lee Green where road closures will be installed on a “trial” basis. Such schemes are a part of the Mayor of London’s Transport Strategy.**

**The Mayor’s Transport Strategy includes dictating how you travel.**

Roads such as Upwood Road, Cambridge Drive, Manor Park and Manor Lane and many more will be closed which will be particularly inconvenient. That will effectively block many routes and divert vehicles onto the heavily congested A20, A2212 and A205.

Queues of traffic on the main roads will lengthen and bus journey times increased.

If you respond to this leaflet we will send you a map of the proposed closures.

If you are likely to be affected by these proposals you should certainly contact your local councillors and voice your objections.
