



London Borough of Lewisham

The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Covid-19) (Phase 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

Made 22nd June 2020.

Coming into force 6th July 2020.

The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham, being satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited in lengths of various roads in the said London borough because of because of the likelihood of danger to the public on and adjacent to the highway, in exercise of powers conferred by section 14(1) of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended by The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which allows modal filters to be provided for social distancing measures at various locations shall come into force on the 6th day of July 2020 and will remain in force for a period not exceeding 18 months and may be cited as The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Covid-19) (Phase.1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020.

2. Except as provided in articles 3(1) and 4 of this order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle, except motorcycles, to:-

- (i) Enter South Row from Montpelier Row and Prince of Wales Road;
- (ii) Enter Montpelier Row and Prince of Wales Road from South Row;
- (iii) Enter or proceed in George Lane between a point 2 meters east of the projected boundary of Nos. 173/175 George Lane and a point 5 meters west of the projected boundary of Nos. 175/177 George Lane;
- (iv) Enter or proceed in Glenbow Road between a point 5 meters south of the projected boundary of Nos. 50/52 Glenbow Road and the projected southern boundary of No. 52 Glenbow Road;
- (v) Enter or proceed in Kitto Road, between the western kerblines of Pepys Road and a point 9 meters west of western kerblines of Pepys Road;
- (vi) Enter Bishopsthorpe Road from Silverdale Road;
- (vii) Enter Silverdale Road from Bishopsthorpe Road; and
- (viii) Enter or proceed in Silverdale between a point 3 meters north of the projected northern kerblines of Grace Path and a point 5 meters north of the projected northern kerblines of Grace Path.
- (ix) Enter or proceed in Scawen Road between the projected southern boundary of No 63 Scawen Road and northern kerblines of Grinstead Road.

3. (1) The prohibitions imposed by article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016(b) placed on the highway, or as the case may be, temporarily obliterated on the highway.

(2) During the period that this order is in force and any of its provisions indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway, if and so far as any such provision of this order conflicts or is inconsistent with a provision of any other order the provision of this order shall prevail.

4. The prohibitions imposed by this order shall not apply to any motorcycle, any vehicle engaged on highway maintenance works at those locations, any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency or anything done with the permission or at the discretion of a police officer in uniform.
